Getting Back to Breast Screening

A June 10th Aunt Minnie article reported that 75% of U.S. screening mammography hospitals and imaging centers have resumed screening operations. Also, Volpara Solutions data reported that exam volumes are recovering rapidly. At many sites, volumes have returned to within 10% of pre-pandemic levels, and some facilities have volumes higher than previous levels.
